This is an opportunity to show pride in your property and help our community appreciate its special architectural and/or cultural heritage.



How to Apply

Apply using the attached form. Include any known information about the structure/site and its origins (from the deed, census, tax listings, etc.), include copies of current (and past) photographs, and other documentation, if available.

The Commission, with the assistance of volunteers from the Historical Society, will review the application and determine if the structure is eligible.

Buildings must have been constructed at least fifty years ago and should retain substantial design character.

The marker serves only to highlight a home, structure, or site that contributes to Fitchburg's rich heritage. Even though the marker has been awarded, there are no restrictions associated with this specific marker awarding. The Commission obviously hopes that its integrity will be maintained. Other local, state, and federal regulations may apply to some properties.

Plaque Details

Deep red background with white lettering and accents on durable painted wood, oval-shaped, approx. 11" high x 16" wide, attached with two screws, included, and with holes pre-drilled. Delivery may take up to 90 days.
